Where to stay:

Fishing Info:

Apalachicola is a historic town that was one of the largest seaports in the Gulf dating back to the mid 1800s. It is situated on the Apalachicola River, which is noted by many chefs for having some of the finest oysters in the country. Apalachicola's inshore waters offer excellent opportunities for redfish, flounder, sheepshead and trout. Offshore, Apalachicola offers some of the best natural bottom fishing waters in the Gulf, as well as many artificial reefs. Anglers will be able to start the red snapper season off with a bang as this year's tournament has an open season for these tasty critters that should be in abundant numbers. Vermillion and mangrove snapper are also plentiful in these waters. This fishery is also rich in Cobia, Spanish and King Mackerel, Grouper (especially Gag and Red Grouper), Amberjack (season will be closed), and further offshore you will find Mahi, Wahoo, and Tuna. Also, don't be surprised if you run across a billfish further offshore.

Directions:

Take I-75 out of Atlanta to Tifton. Pick up hwy 319 through Thomasville and Tallahassee. Merge onto hwy 98 West in Panacea and continue on approximately 50 miles.
