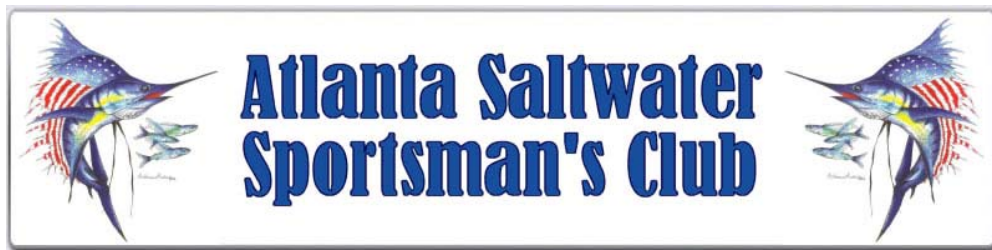

- MONEY:** **\$190 per boat** ~ includes two (2) people (captain & one angler).
\$95 per extra person ~ includes one shirt or jacket, Captain's Party and Awards Banquet dinner. *Extra shirts or jackets are \$50 each.*
- PLACE:** Tournament headquarters will be at Sailfish Marina & Motel. Some boat slips are available at the Lake Park Marina; and some motel rooms and boat slips available at Sailfish Marina (800-446-4577).
- DATES:** Captains' Party, Sailfish Marina – at the "Bimini Room," Wednesday, January 11th @ 6:00PM.
Tournament Fishing Days - Thurs., January 12th through Sat., January 14th.
Awards Banquet - Saturday, January 14th @ 7:00PM (location to be determined)
- DIRECTIONS & LAUNCHING INFORMATION:** **To Lake Park Marina:** From Atlanta, take I-75 South to Wildwood, FL. Take the Sunshine Parkway (Florida Turnpike) to the Ft. Pierce Exit---exit, go one (1) mile East to I-95 South to Blue Heron Blvd. to US 1, turn North (or left onto US 1); just pass the Winn Dixie, turn right onto Silver Beach Road, which takes you directly to the marina and launch ramp. Lake Park Marina is approximately 1 ½ miles north of Sailfish on the west side of the Intercoastal. Contact: Lake Park Marina (561-881-3353). They have a launch ramp, boat slips and truck & trailer parking. All slips have power and water. Lake Park Marina charges \$1.50/per LF per day.
- BEST FISHING:** SAILFISH!!! This is a paradise for the neophyte and the seasoned bill fisherman alike. Winter is the height of the sailfish run, but don't be fooled. They won't jump in the boat! Best bet is to rig live goggle eyes on a 7/0 or 8/0 hook. Slow troll the live bait in 100 to 600 feet of water which is only 1 to 3 miles offshore. Blue and white MARLIN have also been caught using this method. Also, WAHOO, TUNA and DOLPHIN: Troll the ledges and blue water with rigged ballyhoo with a Sea Witch or plastic skirt. Swimming mullet also make good trolling bait.
- BAIT/TACKLE:** Baits, rigs, tackle food, drinks and supplies are available at the marina store at SAILFISH. Texaco fuel is available at the marina also.
