Boat Launching Ramp: the most convenient boat ramp is just down the street from Pirates Bay at Liza Jackson Park (1/4 mile west of Pirates Bay).

Best Bets: This May everything should be open except red snapper and gag grouper. Cobia may still be active in the area. Offshore reefs and wrecks will hold a variety of bottom fish and it is a good time of year for trolling as well. Fish the near-shore waters for king mackerel or try inshore for trout & redfish.

Tournament Format: Fishing Friday and Saturday, ASWSC Points Matrix scoring for tournament and Angler of the Year.
