# TIP SHEET

## ASWSC Rumble on the Redneck Riviera

### Panama City Beach, FL August 16 - 18, 2018

#### When:

- Captain's Meeting: Thursday, 8/16, 4:00 PM @ Treasure Island Marina Pavilion
  - After the Captain's meeting everyone is encouraged to meet at Uncle Ernie's restaurant; as long as it is not raining, we can go by boat if you like, or driving directions will be given to go by car.
- Tournament Costs - \$40 each, \$20 for non-fishers attending Awards Banquet
- Tournament Fishing: 2 days, Friday Aug 17<sup>th</sup> and Sat Aug 18<sup>th</sup>
- Weigh-in at the Marina 5:00 PM – 6:00 PM Friday and Saturday
- A "Mini Rod" side/fun tournament will run concurrently, see the next sheet for details
- Awards Banquet 7:30 PM Pier 77 Restaurant
- Tournament scoring per the official ASWSC Points Matrix

To reserve a slip, call or email Dave, tell him you are with the ASWSC for the rates. (You probably want to also say it is for the tournament Chuck Alford set up.)

- The Marina rates for this event are \$1.50/ft per night, and that includes launching and trailer storage.
- The Marina has fuel and ice open 24hrs and a ships store with some tackle and bait.
- The Weigh in will be at the Marina and there is a nice fish cleaning area.
- Half Hitch Tackle is 2 miles down the road
- There is a *Twice the Ice* at Half Hitch, and one between there and the Marina (this one takes credit cards); to be honest, I like the convenience of buying ice at the marina and I think it is harder and last longer.
- There is a bait barge to the right as you head to the pass that sells Cigar Minnows and Pinfish, cheaper than Lavar, but you can't reserve and they may run out of you don't get there early.

#### **Awards Banquet 7:30 PM Saturday:**

Pier 77 Restaurant 3016 Thomas Dr, Panama City Beach, FL 32408

Right on Thomas Dr out of the Marina and Pier 77 is a mile or so on the left. I need a good head count of attendees a week ahead and meal selection by the Captain's meeting. The available menu selection will be sent out ahead of time.

#### **Where to stay:**

There are literally hundreds of condos for rent within a couple of miles of the marina. (Google PCB condo rentals. Thomas Dr, the "big bend" where Thomas Dr turns and follows the beach, is the area to look in). The 3 largest condos nearby are Treasure Island, The Commodore and Moonspinner, but there are many smaller sets of condos also, some on the beach and many a block off the beach and cheaper. Lots of rental management companies and lots of VRBO. There is a Hampton Inn a mile away, La Quinta a couple miles away, and a Fairfield Suite about 4 miles away. If you like to camp, St Andrews State Park is about 3 miles away and is very nice.

#### **What to Expect:**

- PCB has probably around 150 artificial reefs, many of them pretty big. You can download the Bay County reefs online, but your best source is the Half Hitch chart, along with the numbers you can see the layout.
- Also check [www.mbara.org](http://www.mbara.org) for the Mexico Beach reefs. Lots of reef balls 25 miles out.
- There are some live bottom areas starting about 20 miles from the pass.
- The Madison Swanson area is almost as close as it is to Apalachicola, so fishing areas near it are 50-60 miles.
- Amberjack season opens August 1st and the PCB area has dozens of large relief artificial reefs that are covered in AJ. You may have to wrestle 5 or 10 to get a legal one, but there are worse things in life.
- Triggerfish season will be open in Aug, and along with AJ, they have flourished in the past closed seasons. Most are too small, but there are a lot of keepers out there if you want maybe the best tasting fish in the gulf.
- There are a lot of Redfish and some Trout and Flounder in the bays.
- There will be King and Spanish Mackerel around. The Kings are all up and down the beach from a mile to 40 miles out. Spanish are in the Bay as well as nearshore.
- You never know when a Cobia or Blackfin will surprise you and sometimes you find peanut Dolphin not too far offshore hanging under something floating.
- Grouper will be open, there are a few but not a lot of Grouper in this area without getting 40 miles out or so.

**Mini Rod Challenge – Side Tournament**

This side challenge tournament, along with a trophy, will provide bragging rights for who is the best ultralight angler, most resourceful angler under adverse conditions, and in other words who is most capable of using a rod and reel that any normal 5 year old kid can use?

This side tournament is optional for each individual angler, a boat is allowed to have zero participants, a portion of the crew participating, or full participation by all crewmembers.

Rules for the “Rumble on the Redneck Riviera” Side Tournament

1. \$20 fee for each rod, this include the challenge rod and reel to be provided at the Captain’s Meeting and is the anglers to keep. This will actually be a nice little Ugly Stick Jr combo, made for little kids.
2. There will be a trophy for the winner.
3. The heaviest legal-to-keep fish caught by the supplied rod and reel wins.
4. The fish does not have to be on the ASWSC Matrix to qualify, but it must be legal to be kept. (i.e Ruby Lips, Catfish, etc)
5. The fish can be included in the tournament weigh in if it is a matrix fish, but does not have to be (i.e. if it is not one of the 4 largest of a species it will not be weighed for the tournament, but can be weighed for the side challenge tournament)
6. Runs concurrent with the “Rumble on the Redneck Riviera” ASWSC tournament following all rules of when you can fish, and when to weigh in.
7. Tie Breaker (In the following order)
  - a. If one fish is on the ASWSC Matrix and the other(s) is not, that is the winner
  - b. If one fish is weighed on the first day of the tournament and the other(s) is not, that is the winner
  - c. The winner will be decided by long distance casting contest after Saturday’s weigh in.
8. This tournament is on the honor system that the fish was really caught by the supplied rod and reel, but pictures are highly encouraged (They may look good on the website).
9. Participating anglers may use any terminal tackle they choose, including replacing line that comes on the reel if they so choose, as long as the rod and reel supplied to them are used without being modified (i.e you cannot zip tie the rod to a larger rod)
10. If the rod and reel fail during the tournament, too bad so sad, the angler obviously didn’t know their limitations

This tournament does not require an application since it is only open to participants in the main tournament.
