- Tournament Fishing: 2 days, Friday Sep 20th and Saturday Sep 21st.
- Weigh-in at Treasure Island Marina: 5:30 – 6:00PM Friday and 5:00 – 5:30PM Saturday
- Awards Banquet 7:30 PM Saturday, Pier 77 Restaurant
- Tournament scoring per the official ASWSC Points Matrix

To reserve a slip, call or email Dave, tell him you are with the ASWSC for the rates. The Marina rates for this event are \$1.50/ft per night, and that includes launching and trailer storage.

- The Marina has fuel and ice open 24hrs and a ships store with some tackle and bait.
- The Weigh in will be at the Marina and there is a nice fish cleaning area.
- Half Hitch Tackle is 2 miles down the road
- There is usually a bait barge near the channel as you head to the pass (they have been struggling since the hurricane, but are expected to be fully operational by September). Supply may run out if you don't get there early.

Awards Banquet 7:30 PM Saturday:

Right on Thomas Dr out of the Marina and Pier 77 is a mile or so on the left.

Where to stay:

There are many condos for rent within a couple of miles of the marina. (Google PCB condo rentals. Thomas Dr, the "big bend" where Thomas Dr turns and follows the beach, is the area to look in). The 3 largest condos nearby are Treasure Island, The Commodore, and Moonspinner, but there are many smaller sets of condos also, some on the beach and many a block off the beach and cheaper. Lots of rental management companies and lots of VRBO. If you need to keep your cancellation options open in case the seas turn rough, there are several hotels within 5 miles. If you like to camp, St Andrews State Park is about 3 miles away and is very nice. **Wherever you decide to stay, book your lodging early (like NOW), as Hurricane Michael wiped out much of the availability and rooms are filling up fast.**

What to Expect:

- PCB has probably around 150 artificial reefs, many of them quite large. You can download the Bay County reefs online, but your best source is the Half Hitch chart, along with the numbers you can see the layout.
- Also check www.mbara.org for the Mexico Beach reefs. Lots of reef balls 25 miles out.
- There are some live bottom areas starting about 20 miles from the pass.
- The Madison Swanson area is almost as close as it is to Apalachicola, so fishing areas near it are 50-60 miles.
- Amberjack season opens August 1st and the PCB area has dozens of large relief artificial reefs that are covered in AJs. You may have to wrestle 5 or 10 to get a legal one, but there are worse things in life.
- There are a lot of Redfish and some Trout and Flounder in the bays.
- There will be king and spanish mackerel around. The kings are all up and down the beach from a mile to 40 miles out. Spanish are in the Bay as well as nearshore.
- You never know when a Cobia or Blackfin will surprise you and sometimes you find peanut dolphin not too far offshore hanging under something floating.
- Grouper will be open, there are a few but not a lot of grouper in this area without getting 40 miles out or so.

2019 PCB Yo-Yo Reel Side Tournament



This side challenge tournament, along with a trophy for the winner, will showcase primitive angling skills. Yo-yo reels (also known as Cuban reels or hand reels) are used extensively in undeveloped areas of the world. Anglers who have never held a modern rod and reel often make huge catches on these reels, relying on their own strength and technique to bring the fish in. Catching a fish with this simple rig leaves no room for doubt when it comes to the angler's skill.

This side tournament is optional for each individual angler. A boat is not required to participate; and any number of the registered tournament anglers on board may participate (subject to the approval of the captain, of course).

Rules for the "Rumble on the Redneck Riviera" Side Tournament

1. \$15 fee for each yo-yo reel. This includes the official club yo-yo reel and is yours to keep. You may purchase as many as you like.
2. To qualify for the side tournament, catches must be made with an official club-provided yo-yo reel and caught by a registered tournament angler.
3. Anglers must use the original main line provided on the reel (the reels will be pre-spooled with mono); however, anglers may replace the pre-spooled leader with up to 30 ft of their own leader, which can be made of any type of line (any weight/thickness of mono, braid, wire, etc). Any number or style of sinkers or hooks may be used, as long as the rig does not violate any fishing regulations.
4. Other than the 30 ft of leader, additional line may not be added. If the main line breaks, you may only add another 30 ft of leader and your total line length will be shorter. If you are completely spooled, from that point on you will only be able to fish with the 30 ft of leader, unless you replace the reel with another official club yo-yo reel. The tournament director may have a few extra reels if you need to purchase a replacement during the tournament (while supplies last).
5. The heaviest legal-to-keep fish caught by a registered tournament angler on an official club-supplied yo-yo reel wins.
6. The fish does not need to be on the ASWSC Matrix to qualify, but it must be a legal catch (cannot be illegally harvested).
7. The fish can be part of the tournament weigh in if it is a matrix fish, but it does not have to be (for instance, if it is not one of the 4 largest of a species group it will not be weighed for the tournament, but can be weighed for the side challenge tournament.)
8. Runs concurrent with the "Rumble on the Redneck Riviera" ASWSC tournament following all rules as to when you can fish, and when your catch may be weighed in.
9. Tie Breaker in case of even weight (in the following order):
 - a. If one tying fish is on the ASWSC Matrix and the other(s) is not, that is the winner
 - b. If one tying fish is weighed in on an earlier day than the other(s), that is the winner
 - c. Winner will be decided by a leader-tying contest between the tying anglers after Saturday's weigh-in.
10. This side tournament is on the honor system, but pictures are highly encouraged. (They will also look good on the website).

This tournament does not require an application since it is only open to participants in the main tournament.
